- **FY17 Budget:** The board voted unanimously to adopt the Fiscal Year 2017 budget as presented. The budget includes projected revenue of \$54,453,531 and expenditures of \$52,949,199.
- **Pilot Infant Mental Health Consultant:** The board voted unanimously to approve the proposal for the Pilot Infant Mental Health Consultant for the district's Early Childhood/Pre-K programs.
- **Independent Contractor:** The board voted unanimously to approve a contract with a school psychologist.
