UNIFORM POLICY

All clothing should be maintained in good condition with no rips, tears, holes, etc.

Shirts:

- K-5 **Red** short sleeve or long sleeve polo shirts; light blue shirts allowed for 2011-2012.
- 6-8 **Light Blue** short sleeve or long sleeve polo shirts or dress shirts.

Layering:

Navy sweater vests, navy cardigans (buttoned or zipped), and plain navy sweatshirts (non-hooded) are allowed to be worn over the school polo. School sanctioned or school logo sweatshirts are allowed. The collar of the polo must be visible.

Pants:

- Navy flat front or pleated dress pants. No cargo style pants or "skinny" (tight or form fitting) pants allowed.*
- K-5 Elastic waistbands are acceptable.

Scooters/skorts:

Navy flat front or pleated scooters or skorts are allowed for girls. Elastic waist is acceptable.

Long shorts/Bermuda shorts:

Navy flat front or pleated long shorts/Bermuda shorts are allowed. Elastic waist is acceptable.

Belts:

- K-3 No belts.
- 4-5 Belts are optional. Must be a plain black belt with a plain buckle.
- 6-8 Plain black belt with a plain buckle is required (no textured leather, studs, etc). Required when wearing pants or shorts; belts are optional with scooters/skorts.

Socks and Tights:

White, navy or black socks are mandatory. Any style of sock is acceptable as long as it covers the entire foot. Tights are allowed with Skorts and Shorts. Tights may be white, gray, navy or black and must cover the entire foot.

Shoes:

- K-3 Any **gym** shoe; laces or Velcro closure. Dress shoes are not allowed due to daily P.E.
- 4-5 Any black **gym** shoe; laces or Velcro closure. Shoe may have gray accents but no other color. If there are laces, the laces must be all black; soles must be black, white or dark gray.
- 6-8 All black shoes (either dress shoes or gym shoes); shoe may have gray accents, but no other color; soles must be black, white or dark gray. If there are laces, the laces must be all black. Shoes must not cover pant leg. For girls' dress shoes, the heel should be 1.5 inches or less. For P.E., all students must have gym shoes with laces and non-marking soles.

Jewelry, etc:

Jewelry must be discrete. Chains must be tucked inside the shirt. No facial jewelry allowed. No earrings on boys. No tattoos.

Special occasions:

School picture days are non-uniform days. Certain field trips or other special events (award ceremonies, PBIS rewards, etc.) may also be non-uniform days, *at the discretion of the Principal*. Parents and students will be notified of non-uniform dress days in advance.
